# The Church

## Begins to Flourish

Like many churches in the late 1800's, early 1900's, the Church took time to grow it's membership. Church services at Zachery were not held every Sunday. It was many times twice a month. (1st & 3rd Sunday or 2nd & 4th). Members would utilize other Sundays to fellowship with other churches.



## Church Rebuilt in 1965

**Zachiest Chapel was rebuilt under the leadership of Dr. A.L. Curry. The church name was then changed to Greater Zachery. At this time, Greater Zachery became a full-time church.**
